- **New! Science National Honor Society Applications - Live!**

Deadline to apply is Friday Jan 15. Requirements: You must meet the minimum requirements listed below.

- Junior or Senior year – currently enrolled in an AP or IB science class or the ACA Biology 101 and 102 classes (counselor verification required)
- 3.5 cumulative unweighted G.P.A.
- 3.00 unweighted GPA in only your science classes
- have taken at least one advanced, ACA or pre-Bac science class in 9th or 10th grade (counselor signature/confirmation required for verification)
- Teacher recommendation from a previous science teacher. The teacher must complete a digital recommendation.

- **New! REVIVE! Training**

In response to the increasing number of opioid (pain pills, heroin, etc.) overdoses, Hanover County Community Services is providing a training called REVIVE! to PHHS students. REVIVE! provides training on how to recognize and respond to an opioid overdose emergency with the administration of naloxone aka Narcan.

This training is 1 hour long and covers understanding opioids, how overdoses happen, risk factors for opioid overdose, and how to respond to an opioid overdose. This training is FREE OF CHARGE and at the end of the training participants will receive a training card and blue REVIVE kit; the kit contains a pair of vinyl gloves, 2 pocket face shields, instruction card, and stickers.

We are offering two REVIVE training sessions that will be held in the PHHS Auditorium on Monday, January 24, 2022. Session 1 begins at 10:00 a.m. and Session 2 begins at 11:30 a.m.

The areas of instruction include: Automotive Technology; Electricity; Carpentry; Heating, Ventilation and Air Conditioning (HVAC); Cosmetology; and Culinary Arts. Programs at The Hanover Center for Trades and Technology will prepare students for a wide range of opportunities including post-secondary education, apprenticeships and career pathway success. Programs are designed in two sequential learning levels. Students will attend classes every other day for three blocks with transportation provided.
