- **Make-up Picture Day! - This Week**

Express Yourself! The FINAL Underclass Makeup Picture Day will be on Friday, November 19. Makeup pictures are only for students that have yet to take a picture. Retakes are only available for students that purchased a package and are unsatisfied with their picture. Return the original, complete package to the photographer. Wear solid, bright colors to enhance your portrait. Avoid reflective jewelry.

- **Advanced Placement Information**

Due to College Board regulations, it is already time to start thinking about AP exams, which will be administered in May 2022. To ensure that you have an AP exam ordered for you, the following steps must be completed. Please note this process is different from last year's process.

Each AP exam costs \$96. The final deadline for payment is March 9, 2022 for all high schools in Hanover County. No money will be collected after this date.

1. Ensure students are enrolled in their College Board AP classroom accounts for EACH AP class they are registered for.
2. Pay for the AP exam(s) you choose to take by March 9, 2022. Each exam is \$96. If you believe you qualify for a fee reduction, please see Mrs. Day for further instructions.
3. Any adjustments to registrations after November 15th, will result in a \$40 charge.
Example: Adding an exam after November 15th will be \$96 + \$40 = \$136

Example: Canceling an exam after November 15th will result in a refund of \$56 (\$96-\$40=\$56)

4. Students have been asked to commit to which AP exams they want to take by filling out this form (bit.ly/APCommit).

- **National Honor Society Applications**

National Honor Society applications will be accepted November 3-November 19. Membership in the National Honor Society is based on scholarship, leadership, service, and character. Students who are eligible to apply for admission must meet the following minimum requirements:

- currently a junior or senior at PHHS,
- have been in attendance for a period of at least one semester at Patrick Henry,
- have a minimum unweighted cumulative GPA of 3.5,
- participate in extracurricular activities and have leadership experience, and
- have two faculty recommendations submitted.

If you are currently a 10th or 11th grade student and would like to attend the Center for Trades and Technology in one of the following areas next year you must complete this application by February 1st. The areas of instruction include: Automotive Technology; Electricity; Carpentry; Heating, Ventilation and Air Conditioning (HVAC); Cosmetology; and Culinary Arts. Programs at The Hanover Center for Trades and Technology will prepare students for a wide range of opportunities including post-secondary education, apprenticeships and career pathway success. Programs are designed in two sequential learning levels. Students will attend classes every other day for three blocks with transportation provided.

- **New! SOAR Virginia Program**

Attention 10th Graders! Would you like up to \$2,000 towards your college education? You may be eligible to be a part of the SOAR Virginia program. SOAR Virginia is an early commitment program created to inspire and assist high school students to reach their post-high school goals. It is sponsored by Virginia 529 College Savings Plan, an independent agency of the Commonwealth of Virginia and brought to you by participating college access providers.

To enroll in SOAR Virginia, students must meet eligibility requirements including:

1. Be a U.S. citizen or legal U.S. resident
2. Be a Virginia resident and a student in grade 10 and enrolled in a participating Virginia High School at the time of enrollment.
3. Comply with the SOAR Virginia Pledge, including the minimum cumulative GPA of 2.5 or higher at the time of enrollment.
4. Qualify to participate in the Federal National School Lunch Program.

If you meet the requirements, please fill out the form found in your School Counseling Office by November 19th. Students who meet all the requirements will be selected on a first come, first serve basis. Those selected will be contacted by Mrs. Lara Brown, your SOAR Virginia advisor.

- **Virginia Tech Pamplin Leadership Award:**

Attention Seniors! Mrs. Edwards is currently accepting applications for the Virginia Tech Pamplin Leadership Award through Tuesday, December 7 at 11:59 p.m. The Pamplin Leadership Award is a one-year, merit-based \$5,000 Virginia Tech scholarship presented to up to 40 qualified students chosen from Virginia's public high schools. The award was established to acknowledge students who demonstrate superior intellectual promise, academic performance, dedication to their communities, interest and success in physical fitness and health, and unimpeachable integrity. The chosen nominee for our high school must have a 3.8 cumulative weighted GPA or better and have submitted their undergraduate admissions application to Virginia Tech.
